Governance Representative Selection Process

The Nlaka'pamux Nation Health Governance Representative works collaboratively with the NLX Community Engagement Coordinator and NLX Technical Rep. They provide coordination of health issue discussions, facilitate information gathering, and communicate outcomes and direction for the Chiefs to the Interior Region Nation Executive table.

The Nlaka'pamux Nation Health Governance Representative aims to improve health outcomes for First Nations people in the Interior Region through participation at IRNE and by acting as a conduit of information between First Nations Health Authority, Interior Health Authority and Nlaka'pamux Chiefs.

It is intended that the Nation Representative will engage in dialogue, identify linkages, develop networks with the Health Service providers, and provide information and guidance to the various committees that reflects the health needs and desires of the Nlaka'pamux Nation.

Requirements:

- Be knowledgeable of current health matters
- Knowledgeable in funding profiles and processes for health programs and services an asset
- Good communication and writing skills
- Able to work with Nation Membership and Chiefs
- Able to attend and travel to various Nation and Interior Region Meetings,

Selection Process: (shortened due to current timeline)

- October 4, 2021 —Call for Nominations
- October 12, 2021 —Review Nominations
- October 19, 2021— Election at Nation Health Caucus meetings
